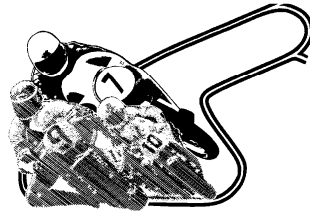

**SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS FOR FIVE MOTOR CYCLE ROAD RACE MEETINGS AT
AINTREE RACECOURSE, LIVERPOOL**

On Saturdays 14th May, 11th June, 9th July, 13th August and 17th September, 2011

Riders and passengers under 18 years of age must also complete a “Parental Agreement” form in addition to an Entry Form to permit them to compete. Their Parent or Legal Guardian must attend signing on with them, and must be available for the duration of each meeting.

Parental Agreement forms are available from the organisers and from the A.C.U.

1. ANNOUNCEMENT AND JURISDICTION

The Aintree Motor Cycle Racing Club Limited will hold five European Open Road Race Meetings for members of the Aintree Motor Cycle Racing Club Limited for Solos and Sidecars at Aintree Motor Racing Circuit, Liverpool on Saturdays 14th May, 11th June, 9th July, 13th August and 17th September 2011. The Meetings will be held under the National Sporting Code and The 2011 Standing Regulations for Road Race and these Supplementary Regulations, together with any Final Instructions subsequently issued or official announcements made. Race timing will be by transponders. Competitors wishing to be included in the official results must have transponders fitted (at their own cost) to their machines. Transponder Number must be included on all Entry Forms

3. SECRETARY OF THE MEETING

4. THE COURSE is at Aintree Racecourse, Liverpool

Course Licence No: 007. The course is 1.535 miles long and will be in a clockwise direction. Minimum width of track is 35ft. Maximum number of starters racing: Solos 40; Sidecars 24. Maximum number of starters practicing: Solos 60; Sidecars 36.

5. ELIGIBILITY

All competitors must be a member of Aintree MCRC and hold a current Competition Licence for Road Racing, issued by the ACU or SACU or another European FMN affiliated to the UEM. Competitors from a European FMN other than the ACU or SACU must provide permission to start from their own FMN that must confirm insurance to minimum FIM Standards.

6. ENTRIES

Entries must be made on the Official Entry Forms and sent to the Race Entry Secretary **David Edwards, 2 Oakhead, Leigh, Lancashire, WN7 3EE (Telephone 01942 670370)** to arrive not later than the dates shown on each Entry Form. All entries must be accompanied by a stamped, self-addressed envelope. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry.

7. ENTRY FEES AND INSURANCE PREMIUMS

Solos: £90.00 for the first event entered and £15.00 for each additional event. Sidecars £105.00 per outfit which includes three races. The Aintree MCRC Ltd. Undertake to insure each rider and passenger, indemnifying him or her against third party claims made arising out of the races or official practice, excluding claims by other riders or passengers, entrant, sponsors or mechanics.

No refunds can be made unless the Race Entry Secretary has received notification in writing at least 24 hours prior to any Meeting, and all official paperwork and passes have been returned.

8. ADMISSION

Admission Passes are not transferable and are valid only up to 11.00am on Race Day. Solos: 1 vehicle and three people, Sidecars: one vehicle and four people.

9. CHANGE OF MACHINE, RIDER OR PASSENGER

Changes of rider or change of machine in the same class may be permitted at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course. Any change must be notified in writing to the Secretary of the Meeting before 10.00am on the day of the Meeting. Only the holder of an Entrants Licence, being an Entrant, can nominate a change of rider. It is not permitted to change both rider and machine. To prevent any unauthorised change of machine between technical inspection and racing, a further sticker will be applied during machine inspection.

All Solo Classes. 40 entries will be accepted with up to 5 reserves. Sidecars. 24 entries with 2 reserves. Each solo Class will have two races: 1 x 5 lap Qualifier for Final grid positions and 1 x 7 lap Final (Championship) Race. Sidecars will have 3 races: 2 x 5 laps and 1 x 7 lap (Championship) Race. Classes may be amalgamated and race lengths will be determined by the number of entries received, available time and weather conditions. Technical Control starts at 7.30am. Practice starts at approx. 9.15am. Racing commences at 11.00am.

11. TYRES

Slick tyres will be permitted for use in all racing classes except for Formula, SF600, Forgotten Era Classes and all Classic machines (see Standing Regulations).

The use of wet weather tyres on any Classic machines is strictly forbidden.

12. AWARDS

To first 5 in all Final Races, entries permitting Awards will be distributed from 4.30pm onwards

13. CHAMPIONSHIPS POINTS AND AWARDS

Each final race at each Meeting carries ACE of AINTREE Championship Points on a 15, 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2 basis including separate Classes within the same Final.

14. SIGNING ON & TECHNICAL CONTROL

All competitors must sign on before presenting their machines and clothing for Technical Control & Technical Inspection (from 7.30am onwards). All competitors must produce their AMCRC Membership Card and a valid Road Race Competition Licence. Sidecar passengers must provide a valid "sidecar passenger" licence. Competitors from an FMN other than the A-CU or SA-CU must provide permission to start and a current insurance certificate from their own FMN. Any competitors not being able to produce a current licence will only be permitted to start at the discretion of the Stewards and the Clerk of the Course and may be liable to a fine not exceeding £10.00.

15. FORGOTTEN ERA STANDING REGULATIONS

The Forgotten Era Standing Regulations are available to download on the Aintree MCRC website

16. PRACTICE

Practising will start at approx 9.15am. Every rider must complete a minimum of two laps practice in order to qualify for racing.

No extra practice will be allowed unless specifically authorised by the Clerk of the Course ONLY.

17. STARTING, FINISHING AND GRID POSITIONS

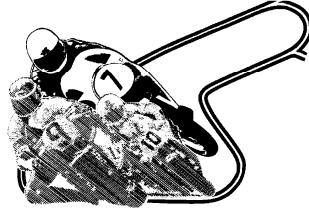
All races will be clutch starts indicated by extinguishing a red light or the National Flag. A chequered flag will be displayed as each winner crosses the finished line. Only riders crossing the finishing line within two minutes of the winner and having completed 75% of the race distance will be deemed as finishers. Grid positions for qualifying races and heats will be determined by Championship positions and known ability for Row nos. 1, 2 and 3 with the remaining rows determined by ballot. Grid positions for all finals will be determined by finishing times and positions in heats and qualifiers.

18. TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded to the first 5 finishers where there are more than 15 starters, the first two finishers where up to 14 starters and the first place where there are up to 8 starters.

19. TRANSPONDERS All machines must have a transponder fitted.

Competitors must provide their own transponder. A small number of spares are held by the timekeepers but must be pre-booked and a hire fee paid on Race Day. The onus on ensuring the device is correctly fitted and maintained throughout the competition rests with the rider.

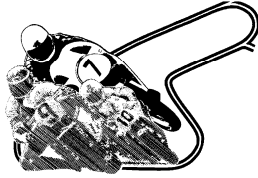
